Muriel's work in the field of traditional Scottish music has taken her from Scotland to the United States of America, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Japan and Europe. Her reputation as one of the finest musicians currently playing for Scottish dance puts her in great demand for workshops, dances and concerts, both as a solo artist and together with other musicians.

During her career Muriel has had several wonderful musical liaisons since her first band gig with Bobby Crowe. These include Marian Anderson, Chris Duncan, Angus Fitchet, Alasdair Fraser, Iain Fraser, Jim Lindsay, Judith Linton, Calum MacKinnon, Gordon Smith and Keith Smith, to name but some.

Muriel's diversity ensures a very busy life-style and a great deal of traveling as she continues to teach (both music and dance), perform, play for classes and dances, and compose. To date Muriel has released 18 CDs on her own Scotscores label and has appeared on many other recordings. As a prolific composer, Muriel has provided tunes for many dances and for many people throughout the huge Scottish Country Dance world. Many of her compositions have been published and a number of dance books.

The Royal Scottish Country Dance Society recognized her service to Scottish Country dancing and music by awarding her the Society's Scroll of Honour in 2002.

Muriel is currently living in Courtenay on Vancouver Island.
